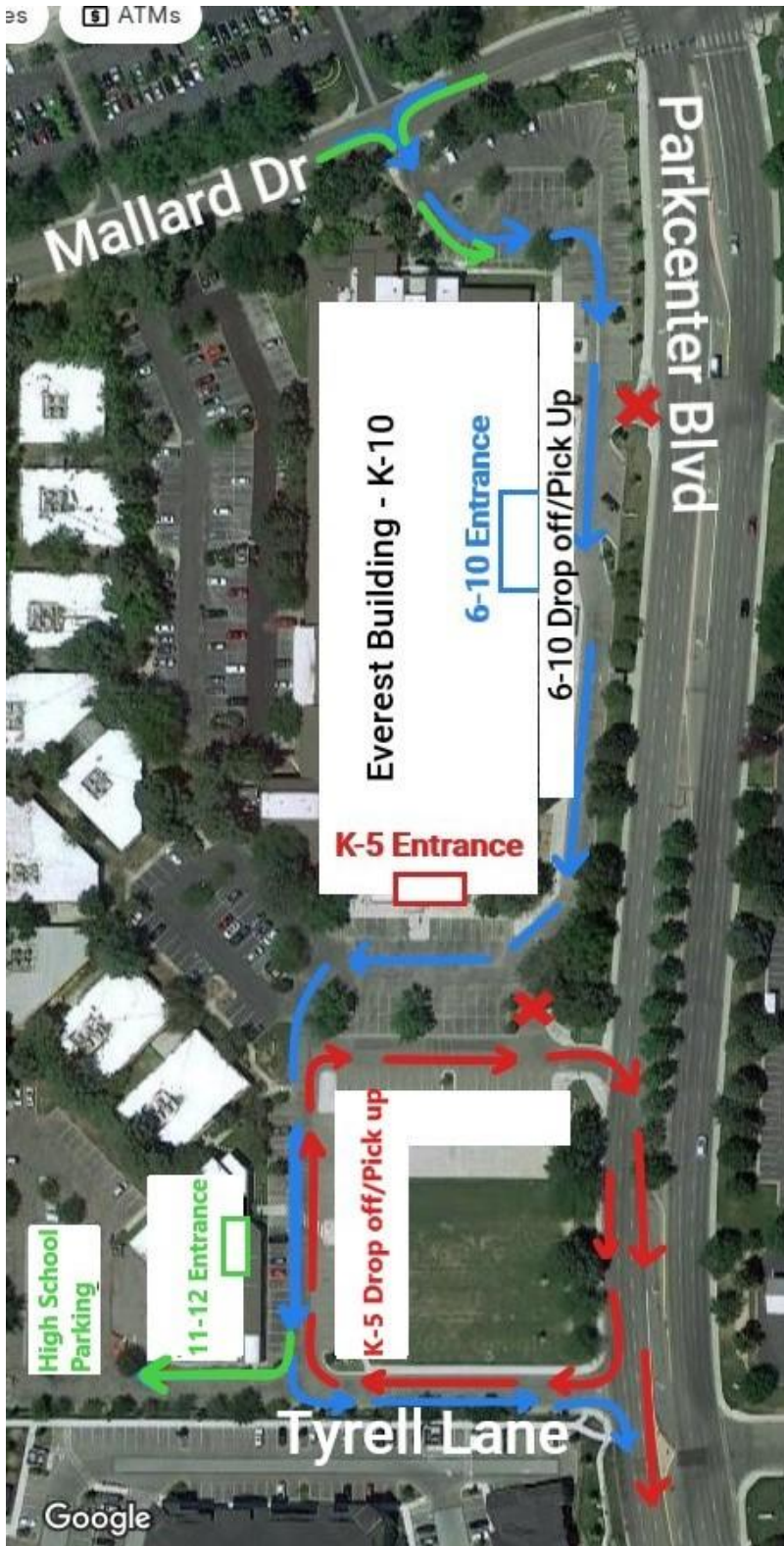


August 5, 2021 - New Traffic Pattern at Sage

- New traffic pattern begins August 9, 2021
- All PYP students (K-5) will be dropped off in playfield
- All MYP students (6-10) will be dropped off along Parkcenter side
- All DP/CP students (11-12) will be dropped off at K1 building



With the redesign of the Sage Campus, we have developed a new traffic pattern and logistics plan that will begin Monday, August 9, 2021. This involves a new traffic pattern for morning drop off and afternoon pick up. Here is how it impacts the various grade levels:

K-5 Traffic please follow Red arrows and enter from Parkcenter past Playfield

6-12 Traffic please follow Blue arrows and enter from Mallard by Smokey Mountain.

- If you have children in K-5 ONLY, you will always drop off and pick up at the playfield. (**Red Route**)
- If you have children in grades 6-10 ONLY, you will always drop off and pick up on the parkcenter side of the main building. (**Blue Route**)
- If you have children in grades 11-12 ONLY, you will always drop off and pick up in front of the 11-12 building. (**Blue Route**) High School drivers, take the blue route and then **green** arrow past your building and park in the back.
- **IF YOU HAVE CHILDREN IN K-5 AND 6-12**, you will always drop off and pick up at the playfield! (**Red Route**)
- If you are dropping off at the playfield (for any of the reasons listed above), you will enter the campus from Tyrell Ln and leave campus at the middle right-turn exit onto Parkcenter. (**Red Route**)
- If you are dropping off for Grades 6-10, you will enter the campus from Mallard, drop off in the "old drop-off line", and exit by going around the playfield to Tyrell and turning right onto Parkcenter. (**Blue Route**)

No matter what grade level, please NEVER conduct a U-Turn at the CapEd Bank. Please go further down Parkcenter and conduct a U-Turn at the legal U-Turn area. Also, please NEVER enter from Parkcenter near the 6-10 Entrance. We are committed to keeping our students safe and need your cooperation to keep our neighbors happy!
