CHROMEBOOK INSURANCE

If you are still interested in purchasing insurance for your child's school chromebook, we have worked with our insurance provider to extend the window through October 31st. Click on the following website to enroll: https://gpo.worthavegroup.com/gpo/drregionalsd/. The annual cost for the insurance is \$28.

Please know that if there is damage to your child's school chromebook, you are responsible for the cost of the repairs without the insurance as outlined in the original chromebook forms. The cost ranges from \$50 to the full replacement cost of \$250.

If you are interested, please sign up by October 31st. The window will not be extended beyond the 31st.

LUNCH MENU UPDATES

The Dighton- Rehoboth Food and Nutrition Department is asking for your patience and support as we navigate new challenges. Nationwide shortages and delays have affected availability of certain food items, leading to substitutions of menu items. These supply issues are occurring throughout the country and are especially challenging for school systems, due to the quantity of meals we serve and the nutrition standards we follow.
